Endorsement of the Sierra Nevada GeoTourism Project

WHEREAS, the geotourism approach is all-inclusive, focusing not only on the environment, but also on the diversity of the cultural, historic, and scenic assets of the County of El Dorado; and,

WHEREAS, the geotourism approach encourages citizens and visitors to get involved rather than remain tourism spectators; and,

WHEREAS, National Geographic Society defines GEOTOURISM as tourism that sustains and enhances the geographical character of the County of El Dorado and the entire Sierra Nevada region—its environment, culture, aesthetics, heritage, and the well-being of its residents.
