**Resolution Amending the Right-of-Way of
Cameron Park Drive and Oxford Road**

WHEREAS, the existing right-of-way for Oxford Road is 50 feet in width, and 80 feet in width for Cameron Park Drive where the two roads intersect; and

WHEREAS, additional right-of-way is needed for signalization and widening at this intersection; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation has petitioned the Board to approve the adjustment of the right-of-way lines on property currently owned by the County of El Dorado and file a Record of Survey depicting this adjustment; and

WHEREAS, Tract 1, as shown on said Record of Survey map, is for widening purposes, while Tract 2 is the remainder property currently owned by the County of El Dorado, and;

WHEREAS, the map is being recorded in Book _____ of Record of Surveys, at Page _____ this _____ day of _____, 2007.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that from and after the date this Resolution is recorded, said right-of-way lines are adjusted to coincide with those shown on said Record of Survey.
