<p>Work completed under the original Agreement is limited to removal of debris and/or obstructions at culverts and critical locations to avoid imminent flooding and/or damage to County facilities (roads, sidewalks) during and immediately following storm events; and on-going monitoring for need for any other maintenance activities allowed under Article III of the original Agreement. One VRF (copy attached) was requested under the Agreement in 2008 for the removal of a beaver dam that caused flooding of the adjacent sidewalk. To date, no other non-routine maintenance has been required or completed within the open space areas covered by the Agreement.</p> <p>Work to be completed is limited to the tasks and activities described above.</p> <p>The amount of time needed to complete work is determined based on conditions of the facilities covered by the original Agreement; observation and monitoring are on-going activities.</p>

The original Agreement replaced a Streambed Alteration Agreement issued to the developer of the Creekside Greens Subdivision for construction activities, upon completion of construction activities in the project area. The Agreement is also required under the Open Space Management Plans for Creekside Greens Subdivision, and by the Memorandum of Understanding between the County and El Dorado Hills Community Services District which describes the maintenance responsibilities of each entity. There is no change in the scope of work from that described in the original Agreement, and no future scope changes are anticipated. Extension of the existing Agreement for an additional five years eliminates additional administrative processes and expenses associated with a new Agreement, resulting in significant cost savings to the County and to the El Dorado Hills Community Services District.
