



RESOLUTION NO. 070-2021

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

WHEREAS, the Sheriff, in his capacity as the El Dorado County Director of Emergency Services, did proclaim the existence of a Local Emergency on March 12, 2020, based on conditions relating to the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the County Health Officer did proclaim the existence of a Local Health Emergency on March 12, 2020, based on conditions relating to the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors did find at its regularly scheduled meeting on March 17, 2020, that the aforesaid conditions did warrant and necessitate the ratification of the Local Emergency and the Local Health Emergency via Resolution Nos. 052-2020 and 051-2020, respectively; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff and the Health Officer both agree the emergency proclamations are not necessary at this time,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that said Local Emergency and Local Health Emergency shall be terminated.


