 viable in California.

In California and many other Western State we need to have more "prescribed
 burns" to reduce the built up fuel in the forests. Fire is nature's way of thinning the
 forest but since wildfires have been suppressed for over 150 years the system is out
 of balance. All agencies of government need to have a streamlined process to
 designate areas for prescribed burns and have ONE agency in charge of the effort.
 in Florida they have a system of one person in charge called a BURN BOSS.
