RESOLUTION No. 249-81

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

WHEREAS, El Dorado County Ordinance Code Section 7626 authorizes the Board of Supervisors to establish pedestrian crosswalks by resolution,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that pedestrian crosswalks are as follows:

(a) In the Township of El Dorado from the Southerly curblīne of Pleasant Valley Road to the Northerly curblīne of Pleasant Valley Road, 112 feet East of Church Street as marked by lines painted on the road surface.

(b) In the vicinity of the Jackson School, El Dorado Hills as marked by lines painted on the road surface.

(c) On Green Valley Road at the Rescue Elementary School approximately 0.27 mile east of Ulenkamp Road as marked by lines painted on the road surface. (2/10/76)

(d) On Carson Road approximately 200 feet East of the Michigan-California railroad spur crossing as marked by lines painted on the road surface. (6/15/76)

(e) On Pony Express Trail approximately 80 feet East of Willow Street as marked by lines painted on the road surface.
