

RESOLUTION No. 243-97

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

RESOLUTION PLEDGING \$17,500 AS FINANCIAL ASSURANCE FOR THE RECLAMATION OF THE SOMERSET SAND MINE

WHEREAS, El Dorado County Department of Transportation is mining decomposed granite from the Somerset mine to control snow and ice conditions on the roads; and

WHEREAS, Section 2770 and 2773.1 of the Surface Mining and Reclamation Act of 1975 and the Public Resources Code Section 2710 requires the surface mining operator to provide the lead agencies with financial assurance for reclamation of mined sites; and

WHEREAS, El Dorado County Department of Transportation is allocated Gas Tax Revenue under Section 2106 of Streets and Highways Codes; and

WHEREAS, El Dorado County Department of Transportation intends to use these "Gas Tax" funds to finance the reclamation of the Somerset Sand Mine; and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that \$17,500 is needed to reclaim the site in 2017:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the El Dorado County Department of Transportation is authorized to pledge Section 2106 funds for the funding of the Somerset Mine reclamation.
