FUNDING AGREEMENT FOR
TITLE III COMMUNITY PROJECTS
#1011-O0810
Amendment I

This Agreement known as FUNDING AGREEMENT FOR TITLE III COMMUNITY PROJECTS, made and entered into by and between the County of El Dorado, a political subdivision of the State of California (hereinafter referred to as "County"), and The Regents of the University of California; (hereinafter referred to as "Recipient");

RECITALS

WHEREAS, County and Recipient have each recognized a compelling need to mitigate the effects of a catastrophic wildfire within communities of El Dorado County, and to that end, Recipient has agreed to cooperate with County to form a partnership to undertake education, planning, and mitigation activities designed to increase the protection of people and property from wildfires.

WHEREAS, the parties hereto have mutually agreed to modify said Agreement, hereby amending **ARTICLE I Designation of Project and Use of Funds, ARTICLE III Term, and ARTICLE IX Notice to Parties;**

NOW THEREFORE, the parties do hereby agree that Agreement for Services #1011-O0810 shall be amended as follows:

ARTICLE I

Designation of Project and Use of Funds: Any remaining funds unspent following the completion of the Angora Area Landscape Restoration Guidelines as described in Exhibit A may be used to develop of up to three defensible space demonstration lots owned by the county including site preparation, landscaping supplies, tools, plants, mileage and travel required to develop the site(s), and for the development and printing of outreach materials to residents about fire safe landscaping and home construction.

ARTICLE III

Term: This Agreement as amended shall cover the period of April 1, 2008 through June 30, 2010, or when all funds are expended by County, whichever comes first.

ARTICLE IX


