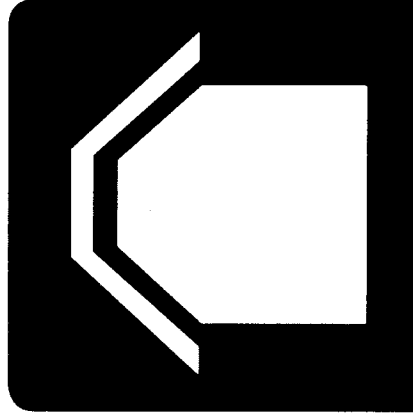

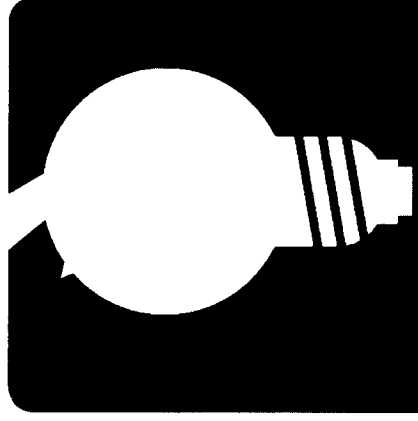

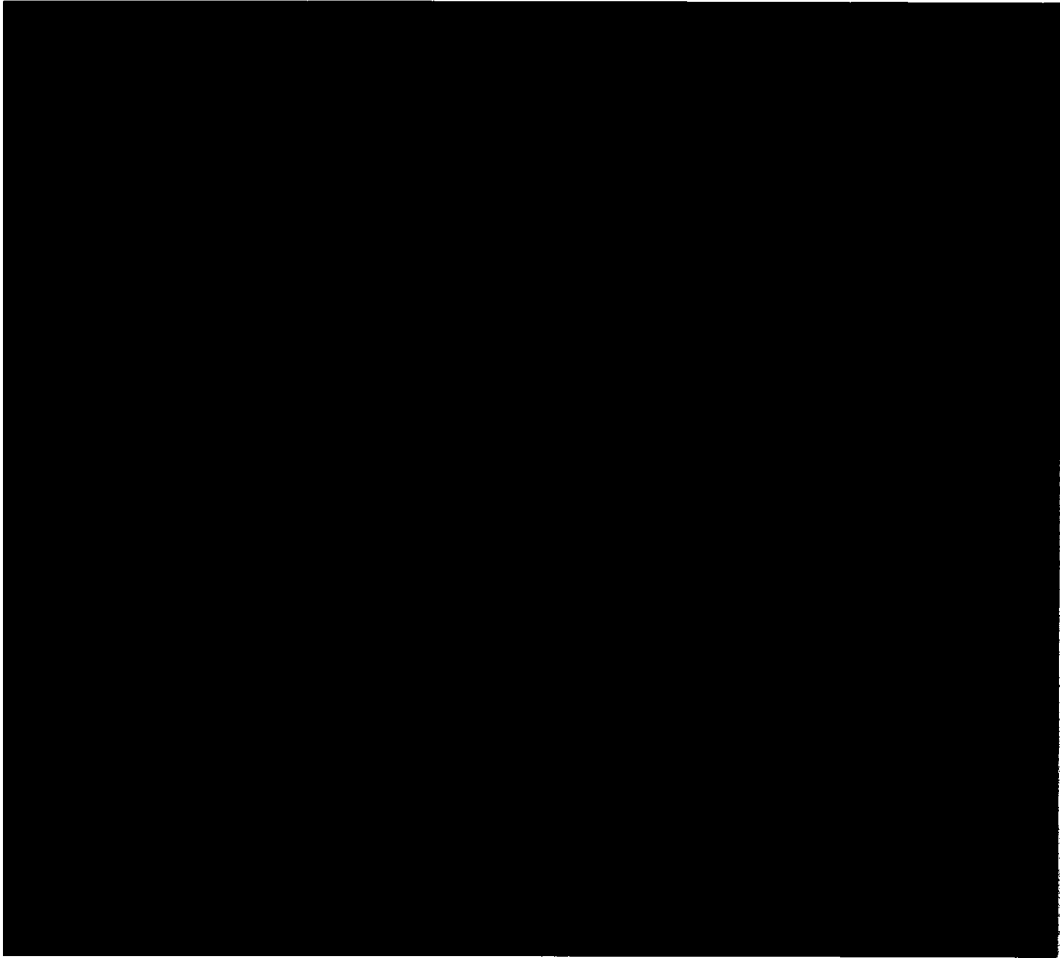
POWER FAILURE
