9. Summary of qualifications

I have an undergraduate degree in Landscape Architecture and after several years as a working landscape architect, I obtained a Master's degree in Environmental Planning from UC Berkeley.

Most of my professional career was built on designing, funding, building, and managing public projects to protect natural resources, provide public access to park lands, and develop park facilities. While working for the State Coastal Conservancy, I helped local, state, and federal agencies and nonprofit organizations obtain funding for and implement public access projects and land conservation and natural resource restoration projects. A highlight of my years there was managing a 300 acre preserve with a 1908 Light Station, and funding and managing the restoration of the Lighthouse.

I was consultant to the Senate Committee on Natural Resources and Water in the California Legislature, so have a good understanding of politics, advising decision makers, and listening to constituents.

During my years working for Yolo County, I completed a county parks master plan, developed a new Parks Department, and brought in over \$20M in outside funding for park facilities. Under the Cache Creek Area Plan, the aggregate mining industry pays a per-ton fee to the county for Cache Creek management, and I negotiated a doubling of those fees as part of a plan update.

All of this experience relates to the issues and activities the County faces in managing and maintaining parks and outdoor recreational facilities, and would make me a useful addition to the Commission.

11. Why do you seek appointment?

I've been living in El Dorado County for almost 9 years, and the variety of outdoor resources here is extraordinary. I hike, raft, kayak, ski and bike in this county, I have expertise that I think could be useful, and I'd like very much to help the County provide good stewardship of the resources it has, develop new ones, and enable its residents to enjoy them.

12. Additional information

While I enjoy a wide range of outdoor activities in El Dorado County, I am especially interested in our rivers and creeks, including the American River. Given that multiple agencies at the local, state, and federal levels have management responsibilities on the South Fork American, I think my experience could be helpful to the County in this effort.
