



***Proclamation of the Board of Supervisors  
of the County of El Dorado***

Declaring March 2010 our "March Against Wildfire" Month

**WHEREAS**, El Dorado County experienced major snowfall accumulations ranging from 8 to 24 inches in the 900 to 3,000 foot elevation range on December 7 & 8, 2009, followed by 5 days of freezing temperatures; and

**WHEREAS**, the lateral and midlevel structure of Blue Oak, Interior Live Oak, Black Oak and Grey Pine does not efficiently shed snow; and therefore a significant increase in surface and ladder fuels of approximately 30% additional fuel loading presently exists; and

**WHEREAS**, although wildfire plays a key role in ensuring the continued health of El Dorado County's natural resources, environment and ecosystems, it can also have devastating effects on the lives and property of our residents; and

**WHEREAS**, El Dorado County's fire and related agencies provide the critical resources to suppress fires and support collaborative, community-based, public awareness initiatives such as becoming a recognized Firewise Community and encouraging homeowners to take responsibility by creating adequate, defensible space around their homes to prevent loss of life and property from wildfire; and


**WHEREAS**, the El Dorado County Fire Safe Council is committed to help prepare our residents for the upcoming fire season through public education, community outreach, and various fire safe assistance programs; and

**WHEREAS**, March Against Wildfire is a vitally important initiative to encourage El Dorado County's fire agencies, organizations and communities to work together to reduce the risk of wildfire through hazardous fuels reduction and increased public awareness.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED**, the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors do hereby proclaim March, 2010 as "March Against Wildfire" Month.
