



RESOLUTION NO. 005-2026

OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE AIR QUALITY MANAGEMENT DISTRICT OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

WHEREAS, Section 29321 of the California Government Code authorizes the Board of Supervisors to establish revolving funds for the use of any Officer of the County; and

WHEREAS, the Air Quality Management District receives cash payments for its permits and fees and requires cash on hand for the purpose of making change; and

WHEREAS, it had been determined that the establishment of an imprest cash account for the Air Quality Management District would meet the recurring demands of daily business; and

WHEREAS, on June 20, 2017, the Board of Supervisors approved the establishment of an imprest cash account for the Air Quality Management District in the amount of one hundred dollars (\$100.00); and

WHEREAS, based on the frequency in which the Air Quality Management District has needed additional change available to meet the demands of daily business, it has been determined that an increased amount is necessary for the facilitation of normal business;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County of El Dorado Board of Supervisors, acting as the Board of Directors of the Air Quality Management District hereby authorizes the increase of the imprest cash account from the currently approved amount of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) to two hundred dollars (\$200.00) for the facilitation of normal Air Quality Management District business. The County Officer of employee with responsibility for administering this account is Rania Serieh, Air Pollution Control Officer, or successor.
