Mr. David Girard has been very supportive of our local area, he has allowed local family gatherings to use his Vineyard for picture taking and drive thru with a private hay ride, he has donated to local fund raisers.

We have seen him picking up trash along Cold Springs Rd. and Thompson Hill Rd.

His vineyard is providing tax revenue thru sales and tourist to the area using other businesses, this would continue with approval of the Special Use Permit.

Noise factor:

We see no adverse affect of music or sounds from music or weddings when taking into account the noise from Gold Trail School playground during the week or on weekends and evenings Little league games and youth soccer and the cheering that goes with it or the busses warming up in the early morning or the evening FED EX cargo planes on final approach to Mather Field 7 days a week and then there is the road traffic noise from Cold Springs rd.

We hear all this every day since we face that direction and have since 1978 and have become accustomed to

the noise. We know that in the past some neighbors, over the years, have complained about the families that used to Gold Trail School field to fly their model airplanes during mid morning hours on some Saturdays which the school discontinued their use do to complaints, this was prior to youth sports on weekends.

We are aware that some neighbors who complain about noise themselves create noise when they have blaring music playing out side while working in yard.
