



PROCLAMATION

Child Support Awareness Month – August 2014

WHEREAS, children have the right to be supported by both parents for their financial, medical and emotional needs; and,

WHEREAS, children grow up to do better in all areas of their lives when they are able to maintain meaningful relationships with both parents; and,

WHEREAS, a 2013 U.S. Census Bureau study reported that nearly two-thirds of noncustodial parents have little or no contact with their children; and,

WHEREAS, the mission of the Child Support Program is to enhance the well-being of children and the self-sufficiency of families by providing child support services to anyone who wants or needs them; and,

WHEREAS, last year the department and local child support agencies collected and distributed more than \$2.3 billion in child support on behalf of the 1.4 million children and families that participate in the California Child Support Program; and,

WHEREAS, the California Department of Child Support Services, in partnership with 51 local child support agencies in counties throughout the state, is commemorating this year's Child Support Awareness Month by spreading the message: "On the road of life, their future starts with you."




