



RESOLUTION NO. 083-2023

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

WHEREAS, the Sheriff in his capacity as the El Dorado County Director of Emergency Services, did proclaim the existence of a Local Emergency on August 17, 2021, based on the conditions relating to the Caldor Fire; and

WHEREAS, the County Health Officer did proclaim the existence of a Local Health Emergency on August 20, 2021, based on conditions relating to the Caldor Fire; and

WHEREAS, the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors did find at its regularly scheduled meetings on August 19, 2021 and August 24, 2021 that the aforesaid conditions did warrant and necessitate the recertifications of the Local Emergency and the Local Health Emergency visa Resolutions Nos. 104-2021 and 114-2021 respectively; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff and the Health Officer both agree the emergency proclamations are not necessary at this time,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that said Local Emergency and Local Health Emergency shall be terminated.
