RESOLUTION OF THE EL DORADO COUNTY TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION PROGRAMMING TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT ACT ARTICLE 3 PEDESTRIAN AND BICYCLE FUNDING TO EL DORADO COUNTY FOR BIKE RACKS AT THE EL DORADO COUNTY GOVERNMENT CENTER

WHEREAS, the El Dorado County Transportation Commission (EDCTC) is the responsible agency for transportation planning for the Western Slope of El Dorado County; and

WHEREAS, EDCTC is responsible for the administration of Transportation Development Act funding; and

WHEREAS, EDCTC has accumulated an unprogrammed balance of \$213,922 in Transportation Development Act Article 3 Pedestrian and Bicycle Funding; and

WHEREAS, the El Dorado County Environmental Management Department submitted a funding request for \$2,992 to EDCTC on April 4, 2008 for bike racks at the El Dorado County Government Center; and

WHEREAS, facilities that serve the needs of commuting bicyclists are an eligible use of pedestrian and bicycle TDA funding; and

WHEREAS, installation of bike racks at the El Dorado County Government Center fulfills goals and objectives of both the El Dorado County Bicycle Transportation Plan and the City of Placerville Non-Motorized Transportation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the funding will be reimbursable to the El Dorado County Environmental Management Department upon completion of the project for a not to exceed amount of \$2,992.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that EDCTC has approved the programming of \$2,992 in Transportation Development Act Article 3 Pedestrian and Bicycle Funding to the El Dorado County Environmental management Department.


