B. Price Analysis:

1. How was the price offered determined to be fair and reasonable? (Explain what basis was used for comparison and include cost analysis as applicable.)

No results were found under a brief search for sex offender counseling or therapist rates in El Dorado County, Placer County, Sacramento County, or California. Al noted individual sessions cost between \$100 - \$200 per hour and a polygraph could cost between \$350 - \$500, but did not state where. A Sex Offender Treatment Speciality position was found in the State of Washington with an hourly rate between \$39.14 and \$52.66. A service in Pennsylvania was found to charge \$100 per individual session, \$45 per group session, \$135 for a polygraph test, and additional psychological testing for \$500 - \$1000.
