SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE

ORDINANCE NO.	

Pursuant to California Government Code section 25124(b)(1), the Board of Supervisors for the County of El Dorado hereby gives notice that, on April 10, 2018, it will hear and vote on the final passage of Ordinance April 24, 2018, amending Chapter 8.76 of the El Dorado County Ordinance Code. The amended "Bear-Proof Garbage Can Requirements Ordinance" would require the installation and proper use of bear-proof garbage cans and enclosures in the defined portion of the unincorporated area of the Lake Tahoe Basin. Generally, the Ordinance will require the use of approved bear-proof garbage can enclosures for all new residential projects; all new and existing vacation home rentals; and existing residences if preventative measures are not satisfying the purpose of the ordinance. The Ordinance also has specific requirements for multifamily residences and commercial premises. After an initial warning, violations of the ordinance are subject to fines of \$200 per violation, with an increase of \$200 per violation for each subsequent violation within two years.
