I believe I have some experience pertaining to CEDAC in addition to the above information. For example, I worked with the County's Office of Economic Development to develop and implement the Divide Business Walk reported in 2014. This was a very positive experience and the resulting report is still in use with our Divide Chamber of Commerce as a guide as we move forward. I co-authored the community and economic development grant for the Divide Chamber of Commerce which was funded last year. We succeeded in our goal which was a welcome sign to El Dorado County in Cool. We were also able to utilize the funds for 4 more community welcome signs on the Divide. I helped again to write the second grant for 2015 which has been approved to further support tourism in North County, as well as the County as a whole. Additionally, I participated in the Regulatory Reform group for two years, working with both the Rural Lands and Ag sub-groups. I also provided input to the draft of the Home Occupation Ordinance which can be valuable to our county and our home based businesses. Thus, I have had the opportunity to interact with some County staff already in the area of economic and community development over the last several years.
