

The undersigned, owner of certain like interest, hereby certifies to the preparation and recording of this map, and hereby consents and offers for dedication to the County of El Dorado the streets and other public ways shown herein including the adjoining lots thereto, for any and all public purposes, and the easements and rights of way shown herein, for the purposes described below:

- (A) Rights of way and easements along the Upper Truckee River for use by County, State, Federal and other public agencies for improvement of drainage, flood control and preservation of fish spawning habitat to a minimum of 30 feet from the mean high water line, on levees or other public structures shall be included in this instrument and an easement of ground, used or such to be allowed, and the construction of such construction projects to be followed.
- (B) Rights of way and easements for water, gas, sewer, and drainage pipes, and for poles, anchors and guys and overhead and underground wires and conduits for electric and telephone service, together with any and all appurtenances appertaining thereto to, and across, and under those strips of land lying between the rear or side lines of lots or lots, and the lines shown herein and designated "Public Utility Easement Line".
- (C) Rights of way and easements for poles, anchors and guys and overhead and underground wires and conduits for electric and telephone service together with any and all appurtenances appertaining thereto to, and across, and under strips of land, 40 feet in width, contiguous to city lot line which is contiguous to city street or other public way and within such lots.
- (D) Easements for gas wires and enclosures over, under and on those strips of land lying 2 feet on either side of and to side there of and extending 25 feet back from the front and/or rear property lines.
- (E) Easements for drainage of surface water over those strips of land lying between the lines shown between and designated "Drainage Easement Line".
- (F) Easements for light and air over those strips of land lying between the front or side and those lines shown herein and designated "SUN BALM LINE", and strips of land to be rear lots and the rear boundaries.
- (G) Easements for snow storage over those strips of land lying between the front of line and those lines shown herein and designated "Snow Storage Easement Line".


