PROTOCOLS FOR PUBLIC COMMENT

Individual Committee members may ask clarifying questions but will not engage in substantive dialogue with persons providing input to the Committee.

If a person providing input to the Committee creates a disruption by refusing to follow Committee guidelines, the Committee Chair may take the following actions:

Step 1. Request the person adhere to Committee guidelines. If the person refuses, the Committee Chair may turn off the speaker's microphone.

Step 2. If the disruption continues, the Committee Chair may order a recess of the Committee meeting.

Step 3. If the disruption continues, the Committee Chair may order the removal of the person from the Committee meeting.

3. [22-1431](#) A Design Review Permit Revision to rebrand the Mobil fueling station and convenience store to a KWIK SERV fueling station and convenience store. Project improvements include: refacing pricing signage, updating freestanding price ID sign, installing LED canopy lights and logo in existing canopy fascia, repainting canopy columns, bumper poles, curbs, and tank lids, reimaging the four (4) fuel dispensers with new factory image, install new KWIK SERV branded tank tags, install two non-illuminated metal price signs, repaint convenience store building, and update building signage with KWIK SERV logo (original DR90-0034). The property, identified by Assessor's Parcel Number 083-340-007, consists of 0.49 acres, and is located on the east side of Cameron Park Drive, approximately 45 feet northeast of the intersection with Country Club Drive, in the Cameron Park area, Supervisorial District 2.
