History of El Dorado County Service:

I served on the original RMAC as it was formed prior to creating Commercial Whitewater Outfitting permits issued in 1982. My service began in 1980 as the commercial outfitter representative and continued without interruption until the late 1990's. I was re-appointed to RMAC as the outfitter representative in 2002 and I have served continuously since that time as the representative of commercial outfitters.

Summary of Qualifications:

I have been a commercial outfitter since 1978 and currently hold commercial permits issued by El Dorado County, the BLM, CA State Parks, and the USFS to operate on the South Fork American, Middle Fork American, North Fork American, Cal Salmon, Klamath, and Scott Rivers. I have not only served as a member of RMAC, I have also been a committee member in creating management plans for the Middle Fork American, North Fork American, East Carson, Klamath, Scott, Cal Salmon, and Upper Klamath Rivers while working with government agencies, stakeholders, and private consultants.

I have been an educator and administrator since 1977 and have worked extensively with boards, committees, and the public in large and small groups while also bridging the gap to County Offices of Education, the California Department of Education, and the Federal Government. I currently am employed by the Department of Labor as Academic Manager of Sacramento Job Corps after retiring as a high school principal in Sacramento, Alameda, and Solano Counties. In addition I provide services as an educational consultant to the Western Association of Schools and Colleges and work as an adjunct professor for Alliant International University.

In addition to RMAC, I also serve on the Outfitter Advisory Committee (OAC) that advises policies and practices of the State Parks concessionaire program on the three forks of the American River.


