



RESOLUTION NO. 109-2026
OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

**WASTE CONNECTIONS OF CALIFORNIA, INC., dba
EL DORADO DISPOSAL SERVICE
Material Recovery Facility**

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on June 23, 2026, for the purpose of adjusting the Material Recovery Facility (MRF) collection rates in the Waste Connections of California, Inc., dba, El Dorado Disposal Service; and

WHEREAS, County Ordinance section 8.42.150 provides that the Board of Supervisors shall set the rates to be charged by a franchisee at such time as the Board deems appropriate; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to County Ordinance section 8.42.170, the franchisee has provided written notice to each ratepayer of the proposed adjustment in a form approved by the County at the time, date, and place of the public hearing to set rates, and the notice was provided at least ten but no more than sixty days before the public hearing; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to County Ordinance section 8.42.170, notice of the time, place, and purpose of the public hearing has been published in a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the County, one each week, for two consecutive weeks prior to such hearing.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that effective July 1, 2026, the following rates are adjusted upward by 4.12 percent (4.12%) for the Placerville, CA, Material Recovery Facility gate rates:

Unsecured Load Fee*

*A fee of 25% applied to the rate for the load will be imposed for any load being brought into the MRF without the vehicle load being covered to prevent waste or recycled material from blowing or falling from the load.

**A fee of 25% applied to the rate will be imposed for any load of mixed waste that includes recyclable material.

Recycling can be dropped off for free if segregated prior to entering the facility.
