



RESOLUTION NO. 095-2017

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado conducted a hearing on the appropriations limit for El Dorado County on June 27, 2017;

WHEREAS, the hearing was advertised and noticed as required by law: and,

WHEREAS, the Board received testimony and other evidence regarding the appropriation limitation to be established for El Dorado County; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado that the El Dorado County appropriations limit for the 2017-2018 fiscal year, as described in Article XIII B of the State Constitution and implemented by Chapter 1205, Statutes of 1980 is the sum of \$203,559,878 computed as follows:

2017-2018 Increase in the California per capita personal income is 3.69% or the factor of 1.0369;
2017-2018 Increase in Population is 0.37% or the factor of 1.0037;
1.0369 (X) 1.0037 = 1.0407 is the combined factor for increasing the 2016-2017 appropriation limitation.

Growth Factor FY 2017-2018:	<u>1.0407</u>
Limit for FY 2017-2018:	\$203,559,878
