New York Creek Trail East – Phase 2 Project Bid Protest Response

The County of El Dorado, Department of Transportation (Transportation) advertised the New York Creek Trail East – Phase 2 Project (Project) and received 7 bids from:

- 1) Pacific Infrastructure Construction, Inc. for \$976,862.50
- 2) McCuen Construction, Inc. for \$1,036,147.00
- 3) Viking Construction Company, Inc. for \$1,137,441.50
- 4) R.A. Nemetz Construction Co., Inc. for \$1,174,650.50
- 5) Bridgeway Civil Constructors, Inc. for \$1,252,680.00
- 6) Granite Construction Company for \$1,376,856.00
- 7) MKD Construction, Inc. for \$1,684,557.00

The Engineer's Estimate for the Project was \$966,727.00

The All Bidders Letter for the Project was issued on Monday, July 9, 2018 which stated Transportation would be recommending the Project be awarded at the July 24, 2018 Board meeting to the lowest bidder, Pacific Infrastructure Construction, Inc. (Pacific) for being the lowest responsive, responsible bidder.

The five-day bid protest period began when the All Bidders Letter was sent and ended July 16, 2018 at 2:00 p.m. One bid protest was received from McCuen Construction, Inc. (McCuen) on July 12, 2018 (attached). McCuen's bid protest states the following reasons Pacific's bid should be rejected:

- 1) Pacific failed to properly identify an American Welding Society (AWS) Certified Fabricator for the Prefabricated Bridge System; and
- 2) Pacific falsely filled out the Public Contract Code Section 10162 Questionnaire in its bid proposal.

Transportation's responses to McCuen's protest are as follows:

- 1) *Pacific Infrastructure Construction, Inc. (Pacific) failed to properly identify an AWS Certified Fabricator for the Prefabricated Bridge System.*

Transportation does not agree that Pacific failed to identify an AWS Certified Fabricator. Page P-17 of the Proposal is a "Certification of Bidder's Pre-Fabricated Bridge Manufacturer's Qualifications" that was required to be completed and turned

in at time of bid by all bidders. Pacific completed this form (attached) and turned it in with their bid stating they would be using Big R Bridge for the bridge system. In addition to the Proposal certification form, Section 55-4.01A of the special provisions does not require the Bidder to certify that the bridge manufacturer is AWS certified at time of bid, only AISC certified, which Pacific did. AWS Certification is required within 10 days of the Notice of Award, which has not happened yet.

Per the AWS website, if a company is AISC certified, all they need to do is pay a fee to become AWS certified. It is reasonable that Big R Bridge will be AWS certified prior to the time required to submit the certification. Transportation has determined this part of McCuen's protest has no merit because we cannot reject for something that was not required.

2) *Pacific falsely filled out the Public Contract Code Section 10162 Questionnaire in its bid proposal.*

The Public Contract Code Section 10162 Questionnaire in the Proposal states:

In conformance with Public Contract Code Section 10162, the Bidder shall complete, under penalty of perjury, the following questionnaire:

Has the Bidder, any officer of the Bidder, or any employee of the Bidder who has a proprietary interest in the Bidder, ever been disqualified, removed, or otherwise prevented from bidding on, or completing a federal, state, or local government project because of a violation of law or a safety regulation?

Pacific answered "No" to this statement. Jay Zoellner, current President of Pacific was the past CEO and President of Nehemiah Construction (Nehemiah).

McCuen has stated that Nehemiah was terminated due to non-performance and violations of law on the 2012 Caltrans Project titled "Sutter County Near Nicolaus From Power Line Road to 0.1 Mile South of Laurel Ave", commonly referred to as the Feather River Bridge Project. McCuen provided links to two websites (printouts attached) regarding this Project and its link to Nehemiah. McCuen also stated they had filed a public records act request with Caltrans, but at the time needed to submit the bid protest had not received a response. McCuen provided additional information July 20, 2018 containing documentation they received from Caltrans (attached).

Transportation, along with County Counsel have reviewed the documentation submitted by McCuen and have determined that McCuen did not provide sufficient information to show that Pacific, any officer of the Bidder, or any employee of the Bidder who has a proprietary interest in the Bidder, has ever been disqualified, removed, or otherwise prevented from bidding on, or completing a federal, state, or local government project because of a violation of law or a safety regulation.

In McCuen's July 20, 2018 response letter (attached), they make a statement that Pacific is a non-responsible bidder. Although the purpose of this item is not to determine responsibility of any Bidder, we have done a preliminary investigation to make a preliminary determination of responsibility of Pacific. Public Contract Code Section 1103 defines a responsible bidder as "a bidder who has demonstrated the attribute of trustworthiness, as well as quality, fitness, capacity, and experience to satisfactorily perform the public works contract." We have confirmed Pacific has a current contractor's license and there are no complaints against either Pacific's or Nehemiah's Contractor's license, they are contractually required to provide performance and payment bonds that will show they have the financial capacity to complete the Project, and they are not listed on either the federal or state debarment list.

Transportation feels it has done our due diligence in reviewing this bid and bidder. We know Nehemiah had a contractual dispute with Caltrans, but we do not know the specifics of that dispute other than what has been presented here today.

In conclusion, Transportation recommends the Board award this Project to Pacific Infrastructure Construction, Inc. as the lowest responsive, responsible bidder.

This bid protest letter is respectfully submitted by McCuen Construction, Inc. ("MCI") to the County of El Dorado, Community Development Services, Department of Transportation ("Owner") for the New York Creek Trail East - Phase 2 Project, Contract No. 2899 ("Project"). MCI hereby protests any intended award to Pacific Infrastructure Construction, LLC ("PCI") of the contract for the Project that was bid on June 27, 2018 (pursuant to the bid protest procedures outlined in the Owner's July 9, 2018 "All Bidders Letter"). As detailed below, MCI is the lowest responsible, responsive bidder, and should be awarded the contract for this Project.

As discussed below, PCI's bid is non-responsive and PCI is a non-responsible bidder since it failed to properly identify an AWS Certified Fabricator for the Prefabricated Bridge System, and also may have falsely filled out the Public Contract Code Section 10162 Questionnaire in its bid proposal.

First, Section 55-4.01C (Steel Structures) of the Project Special Provisions requires that the bridge fabricator/manufacturer possess and submit an AWS Certified Fabricator Certification during the submittal stage (which is ten working days after receipt of Notice of Award). Further, PCI identified Big R Bridge as its bridge fabricator/manufacturer in the Certification of Bidder's Pre-Fabricated Bridge Manufacturer's Qualifications submitted with its bid proposal. The relevant specification 55-4.01C section and PCI's Certification of its Bridge Manufacturer are enclosed with this letter.

MCI has reviewed the list of AWS Certified Fabricators on-line at <https://app.aws.org/certification/CWF/fabricators>, and Big R Bridge is not identified as an AWS Certified Fabricator. Conversely, MCI as a diligent prime contractor, identified a bridge fabricator/manufacturer, Contech, who does possess this AWS certification. MCI highly doubts that Big R Bridge will obtain this stringent fabricator certification in the next few weeks (or when submittals are due), and thus PCI's bid is non-responsive for failing to meet all of the bidding requirements.

Accepting PCI's bid will contravene the bid documents, and will also specifically negate the quality controls intended by those documents – which will have a direct impact on the Project itself. Bids on public projects must strictly comply with the bidding requirements. *Konica Business Machines U.S.A. Inc. v. Regents of the University of California* (1988) 206 Cal.App.3d 449, 454. In this instance, PCI's bid clearly does not comply with the bid requirements since its listed bridge contractor does not and cannot meet the requirements of the specifications for the Project bridge fabrication work. Further, the Owner is required to follow its own rules in awarding contracts. *Pozar v. Department of Transportation* (1983) 145 Cal.App.3d 269-271. The Owner cannot now change the rules set forth in its own bid documents and award the contract to anyone who does not possess the proper certifications or qualifications per the contract/bidding documents. Again, this is consistent with California law, as stated above, and the Owner's bid requirements.

MCI is also informed and believes, and on that basis alleges, that PCI may have falsely submitted its Public Contract Code Section 10162 Questionnaire with its bid. In its bid for the Project, PCI identifies Jay Zoellner as its President. Mr. Zoellner is also identified as the RMM on PCI's contractor's license on the CSLB website. Prior to his involvement with PCI, Mr. Zoellner was the CEO and President of Nehemiah Construction, Inc. ("Nehemiah"), CSLB license # 869322 (we have enclosed a CSLB print out of Nehemiah's license, which expired in 2013).

MCI understands that Nehemiah was terminated for default in 2012 on a Caltrans project known as "Sutter County Near Nicolaus From Power Line Road to 0.1 Mile South of Laurel Ave", commonly referred to as "Nicolaus and/or Feather River Bridge", Caltrans contract No. 03-1A4324. At that time, Mr. Zoellner held the titles of CEO/ President for Nehemiah. After performing internet research¹, it is clear that Nehemiah was terminated due to non-performance and violations of law. Nehemiah was removed from the Caltrans project, and its performance bond surety/DeSilva Gates & MCM Construction completed the project. For initial research confirming the above facts, MCI looked at the following websites:

It is clear that Nehemiah was disqualified or removed from completing this 2012 Caltrans project, and thus was removed from "a federal, state, or local government project." As an officer of Nehemiah, Mr. Zoellner was thus also removed from a state project. By checking "No" in its Public Contract Code Section 10162 Questionnaire, PCI and Mr. Zoellner may not have been truthful in its bid proposal. As a result, PCI's bid is non-responsive.

The purpose of the public contracting statutes is to ensure full compliance with competitive bidding laws as a means of protecting the public from misuse of public funds, to provide all qualified bidders the fair opportunity to join the bidding process, and to eliminate favoritism, fraud, and corruption in the awarding of public contracts. See *Public Contract Code section 100*. Even the appearance or possibility of an impropriety is forbidden in public contracting, even where it is clear that no impropriety occurred. See e.g., *Thomson v. Call* (1985) 38 Cal.3d 633, 649 (the object of conflict of interests statutes of public officials is to limit the possibility of any personal influence). Here, Mr. Zoellner's failure to properly fill out his 10162 Questionnaire and to disclose the above Caltrans project removal is a classic example of impropriety.

In addition, MCI contends that PCI is a non-responsible bidder. The concept of responsibility refers to trustworthiness and the quality, fitness, and the capacity to perform the work. *City of Inglewood v. Superior Court* (1972) 7 Cal.3d 861, 867. Here, PCI failed to comply with, and may have even falsely submitted, bid documents. The Owner cannot trust that PCI will have the capacity or fitness to properly construct this very important Project when it was not able to comply with simple and straightforward bidding requirements.

55-4.01 GENERAL

55-4.01A Summary

Work consists of furnishing, fully engineering, fabricating, transporting and installing a Prefabricated Bridge System of steel construction, including bearings, anchor bolts, deck forms, deck concrete, and deck reinforcement. These specifications are minimum standards for design and construction. The intended use of the Prefabricated Bridge System is to carry pedestrian loads.

55-4.01B Definitions

Not Used

55-4.01C Submittals

Submit shop drawings, design calculations, splicing and erection procedures, warranty information, inspection and maintenance procedures, AISC Shop Certification, AWS Certified Fabricator Certification,

welder qualifications, and evidence of two (2) Certified Weld Inspectors (CWI's) on staff within ten (10) working days after the receipt of the Notice of Award. Upon receipt of the Prefabricated Bridge System submittal, the Engineer will review and approve or request a revised submittal within five (5) working days after the initial submittal. If corrections are required to the submittal, the Prefabricated Bridge manufacturer must remedy all corrections within five (5) working days and resubmit for approval.

Submit shop drawings for all elements of the Prefabricated Bridge System under these special provisions. The design drawings and calculations must be stamped by a licensed professional engineer registered in the State of California.

You must identify the intended bridge manufacturer as part of the submittal. The bridge manufacturer must have the personnel, organization, capability, and commitment to produce fabricated structural steel as set forth in the American Institute of Steel Construction (AISC) Certification Program. Provide the following documentation at time of bid submittal:

- Proof of current AISC certification.
- Verification the bridge manufacturer has been in the business of designing and fabricating steel truss bridges for a minimum of five (5) years and has maintained a permanent quality control department or has retained an independent testing agency on a continuing basis. The agency must provide a report, certified by a licensed engineer, detailing the ability of the manufacturer to produce quality products consistent with industry standards.
- Completion of the "Certification of Bidder's Prefabricated Bridge Manufacturer's Qualifications" statement with the submitted Proposal.

The Engineer will evaluate and verify the accuracy of the submittal after bid opening. If the Engineer determines that the qualifying criteria have not been met, the bid will be deemed non-responsive and subsequently rejected.

55-4.01C(1) Submittal Drawings

Schematic drawings and diagrams must be unique drawings, prepared to illustrate the specific portion of work to be done. Drawings must clearly specify all relative design information, such as member sizes, bridge reactions, and general notes. Provide cross referenced details and sheet numbers on the drawings.

55-4.01C(2) Structural Calculations

Structural calculations must include all design information necessary to determine the structural adequacy of the bridge. Include the following:

- All AASHTO LRFD checks for axial, bending, and shear forces in the critical members of each truss member type (i.e. top chord, bottom chord, floor beam, vertical, etc.)
- Checks for the critical connection failure modes for each truss member type (i.e. vertical, diagonal, floor beam, etc.). Provide special attention to welded tube-on-tube connections.
- All bolted slice connections.
- Main truss deflection checks.
- U-Frame stiffness checks (used to determine K factors for out-of-plane buckling of the top chord).
- Deck design.

55-4.01D Quality Control and Assurance

55-4.01D(1) General

Structural design of the bridge must be performed by or under direct supervision of a licensed professional engineer and done in accordance with recognized engineering practices and principles. The Licensed Professional Engineer is to hold a current P.E. or S.E. license in the State of California.

We in receipt of your July 19, 2018 correspondence, which denied the bid protest submitted by McCuen Construction, Inc. ("MCI") to the County of El Dorado, Community Development Services, Department of Transportation ("Owner") of any intended award to Pacific Infrastructure Construction, LLC ("PCI") of the contract for the New York Creek Trail East - Phase 2 Project, Contract No. 2899 ("Project"). We received today from CalTrans the two enclosed letters, which provide concrete proof and evidence that Nehemiah Construction (which Mr. Zoellner was the CEO and President of) was terminated for cause and removed on Caltrans contract No. 03-1A4324 (which is the project we identified in our July 12th bid protest letter). As the letters indicate, Nehemiah was terminated and removed for non-performance, for failing to suitably prosecute its work, and for failing to comply with various permits and to meet public safety and convenience provisions of the contract. As the letters further indicate, the joint venture of DeSilva Gates & MCM Construction was hired to complete the work.

Clearly, Mr. Zoellner should have disclosed this termination/removal of Nehemiah in the Section 10162 Questionnaire submitted by PCI. Given that PCI falsely submitted its Public Contract Code Section 10162 Questionnaire with its bid, PCI's bid is non-responsive and PCI is a non-responsible bidder for the Project. Based on the above and attached, we request that the Owner grant MCI's bid protest, and award the contract for the Project to MCI.



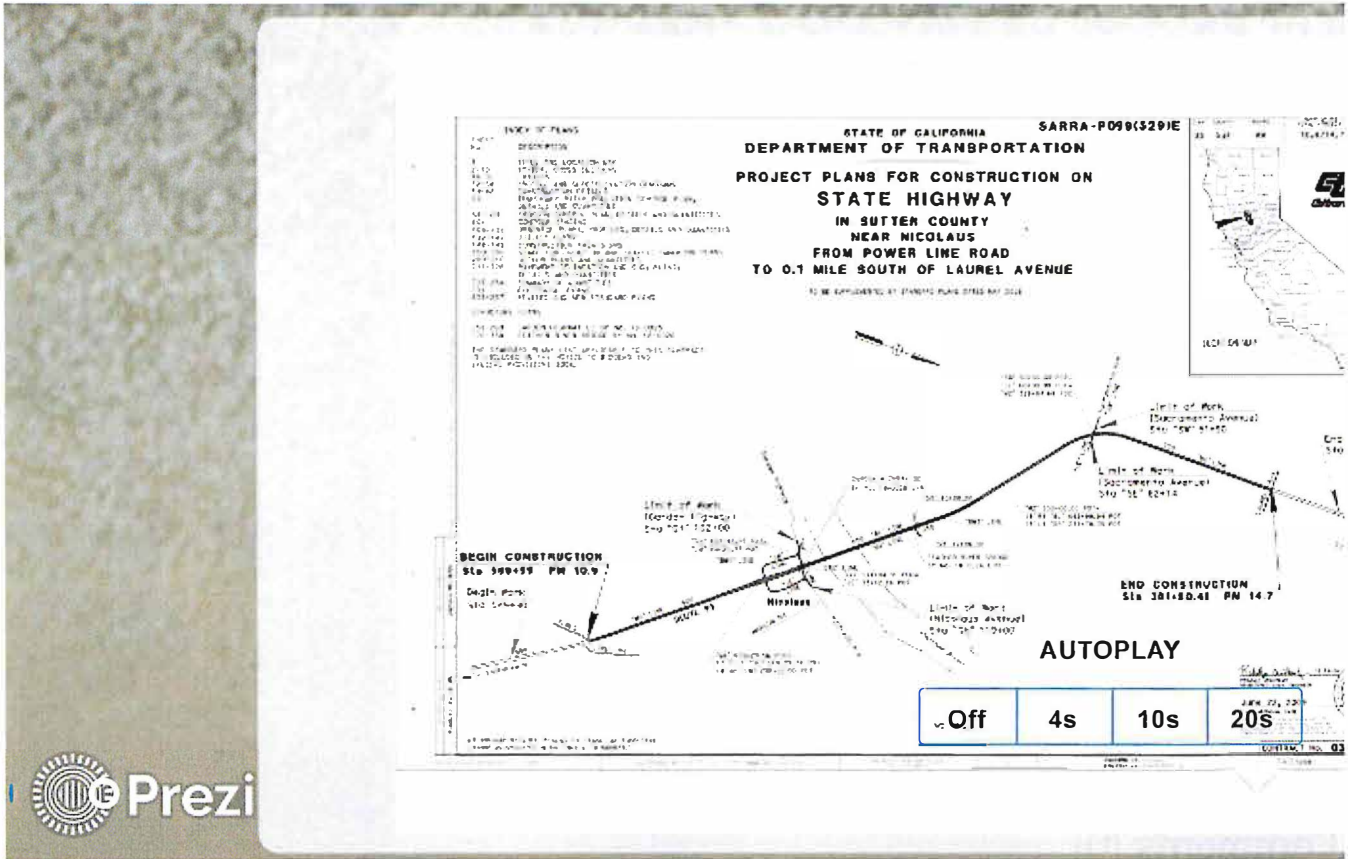

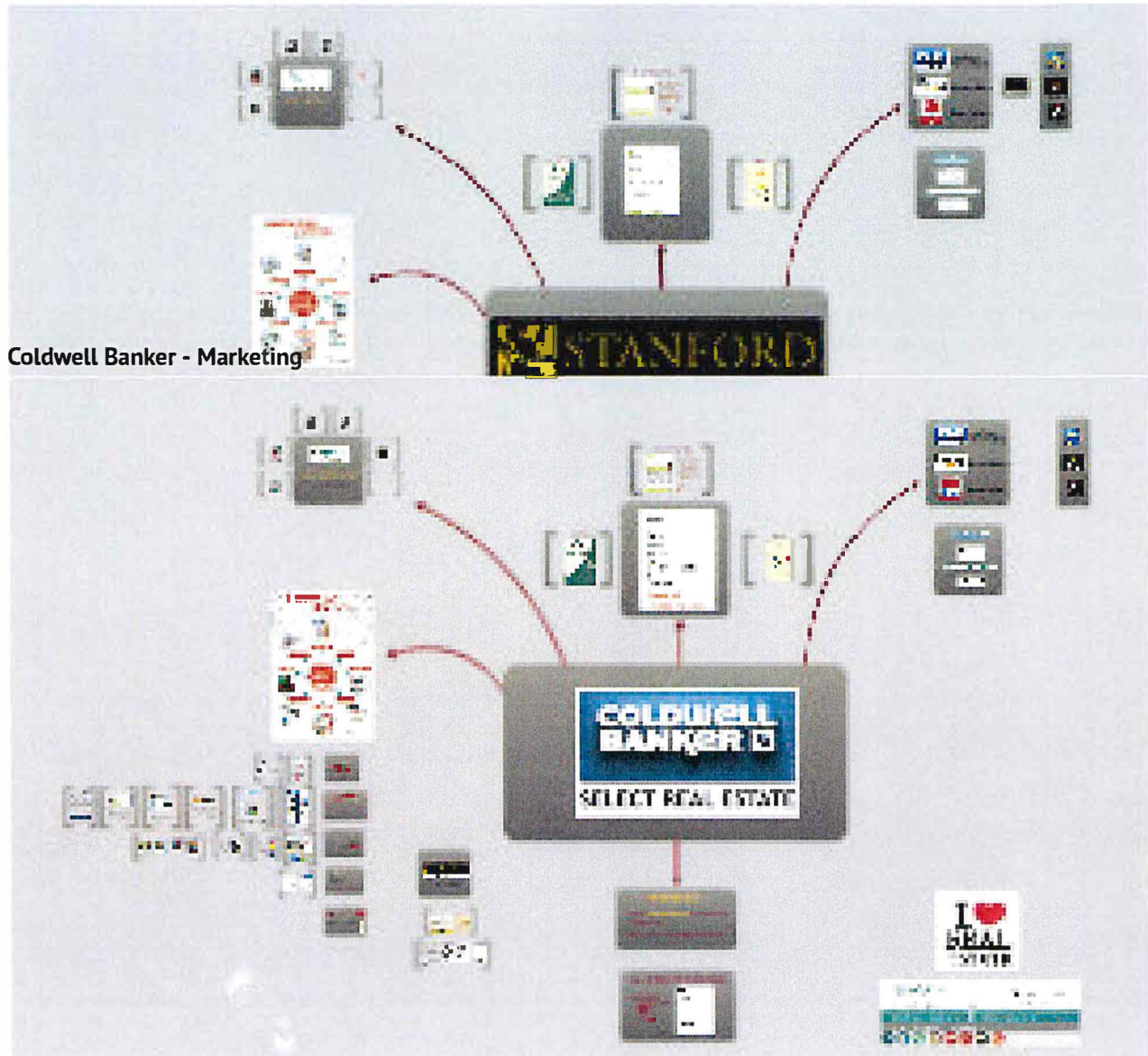

The bridge manufacturer must have the.... To produce fabricated structural steel as set forth in the American Institute of Steel Construction (AISC) certification Program. Provide the following documentation at the time of bid submittal:

- a) Proof of AISC certification
- b) Verification that the bridge manufacturer has been in the business of designing and fabricating for a minimum of 5 years.... produce quality products consistent with the Industry standards.

- c) Completion of the "Certification of Bidder's Prefabricated Bridge Manufacturer's Qualifications" statement with the submitted bid.

PIC specified in the bid proposal that it intended to use Big R Bridge to fabricate the steel pedestrian bridge. Big R Bridge meets the above requirements as required by the specifications. MCI's argument that by using Big R Bridge on this project it will "negate the quality control intended by the" contract documents are nonsensical (See attached Big R Bridge Qualifications).

- 2) PIC's falsely submitted its Public Contract Code Section 10162 Questionnaire with its bid".

Response: MCI has no accurate information regarding neither Nehemiah Construction, Inc. nor the Caltrans project that MCI references. MCI also has no understanding of this section and what it refers to. Unequivocally, Nehemiah Construction, Inc. was not terminated on this project because of a "violation of a law or a safety regulation". Nehemiah Construction Inc. entered into a confidential settlement agreement and left the project because of multiple project issues that were not Nehemiah's fault. MCI's statement regarding this project is baseless and frivolous.

The above responses should clarify the erroneous arguments presented by MCI and such the above referenced project should be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder, PIC.
