Mandated Services


The United States and California Constitutions mandate that government provide legal services to the indigent accused.

We are appointed by the El Dorado County Superior Court and have no choice in what cases we are assigned.


We provide legal services to indigent adults or any juvenile accused of a criminal offense; conservatees (mental health or probate); diversion clients; specialty court clients; contempt case clients; PHF hearings.

Healthy Communities

- •Implement mandated, new Diversion opportunities (mental health, veterans, and general misdemeanors)
- Specialty courts (veterans, BHC/MHC)
- •Maintained all mandated services, despite COVID limitations and challenges.

Good Governance

- •New Case Management System for cross-department communication and ultimately greater efficiencies
- •New application for Grant Funding through BSCC, which will be used to improve services for clients (e.g., Arraignment Court Intervention)
- •Established first Fee Schedule, for appointed clients with funds
- •Promoted "paperless" office environment, with new Case Management System

Public Safety

- •Partnered with the District Attorney's Office and the courts to form and staff a new Mental Health Diversion Court, in addition to Veteran's Court and Behavioral Health Court.
- •Expanded legal services for post-conviction petitions (Prop 47 and AB 1950).
- •Expanded legal services to represent clients who are facing contempt charges from Family Court orders.
- •Kept up with array of criminal justice "reform" (juveniles, adults, and probationers)
