### **Resolution for Road Closure for the 2016 Georgetown “Safe Halloween” Event**

**WHEREAS**, The Georgetown Divide Recreation District (sponsor) desires to hold the 2016 Georgetown “Safe Halloween” Event on Monday, October 31, 2016; and

**WHEREAS**, said sponsor has requested a “Road Closure Permit” pursuant to Vehicle Code 21101(e), Ordinance Code §12.37.010 et seq., and County Resolution 110-79 in order to promote the 2016 Georgetown “Safe Halloween” Event on Monday, October 31, 2016; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that a road closure will be in effect for Church Street between Highway 193 and School Street, and partial closure of Harkness Alley, Orleans Street, and Placer Street where they intersect with Church Street in Georgetown, on Monday, October 31, 2016, between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m., subject to the conditions set forth in Resolution No. 110-79 dated May 1, 1979, and subject to the conditions set forth in the “Application for Road Closure” submitted for this event.

This Resolution and the “Road Closure Permit Application” with fulfilled conditions shall together constitute the “Road Closure Permit”.
