**Subject:** Major Update to the Traffic Impact Mitigation Fee Program and the Capital

Improvement Program Proposed Schedule

#### **PURPOSE**

On September 17, 2010 the Board of Supervisors (Board) directed the Department of Transportation to expedite the Major Update to the Traffic Impact Mitigation (TIM) Fee Program and Capital Improvement Program (CIP) as required by the General Plan and in compliance with state law.

The following proposed schedule will allow the adoption of an updated TIM and CIP prior to 2021. The schedule is extremely constricted and any delay in responses for requested Board direction, any general plan amendments, or the requirement of additional environmental work will delay the project and push the schedule beyond the end of the 2020 calendar year.

Transportation staff and their consultants will be presenting to the Board various policy issues that can affect the TIM Fee Program. Most issues will have an accompanying Technical Memorandum. Each technical memorandum covers a specific policy subject as it relates to implementation of the TIM Fee Program. Other projects that could affect the schedule include completion of the Master Circulation and Financing Plan for the Missouri Flat Area (MC&FP) Phase II. The MC&FP Phase II is an integral part of funding of the TIM and CIP in the Missouri Flat area.

### Next Steps

DOT is requesting the Board receive the proposed schedule and direct staff to coordinate with the CAO's office, the Clerk of the Board, Planning and Building Department, Auditor's office and County Counsel to implement the schedule.
