



RESOLUTION NO. 120-2018
OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado conducted a hearing on the appropriations limit for El Dorado County on June 12, 2018;

WHEREAS, the hearing was advertised and noticed as required by law: and,

WHEREAS, the Board received testimony and other evidence regarding the appropriation limitation to be established for El Dorado County; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado that the El Dorado County appropriations limit for the 2018-2019 fiscal year, as described in Article XIII B of the State Constitution and implemented by Chapter 1205, Statutes of 1980 is the sum of \$213,493,600 computed as follows:

2018-2019 Increase in the California per capita personal income is 3.67% or the factor of 1.0367;
2018-2019 Increase in Population is 1.17% or the factor of 1.0117;
 $1.0367 (X) 1.0117 = 1.0488$ is the combined factor for increasing the 2017-2018 appropriation limitation.


