Agricultural Commission Appointment for January 12, 2010 Board Meeting

The El Dorado County Agricultural Commission is comprised of seven members not officials of the county, appointed by the Board of Supervisors, representing the following industries: Forestry/Related (1), Livestock (2), Fruit and Nut Farming (2), Agricultural Processing (1), and Other Agricultural Interests (1).

In accordance with the Agricultural Commission Bylaws adopted by the Board of Supervisors on August 31, 2004, a Notice of Terms of Office Expiration was submitted to the local newspapers and to county agricultural organizations regarding the expiration of one of the two Livestock Industry representative terms. In anticipation of receiving several applications, an independent Review Panel comprised of industry representatives as specified in the Agricultural Commission By-Laws § 4(a), was tentatively scheduled to meet on December 4, 2009, to review applications and interview candidates. Applications were required to be submitted to the EDC Department of Agriculture office by close of business November 20, 2009. As a result of the notifications, the incumbent Livestock Industry member was the only applicant thus revoking the necessity for convening the review panel.

It is my recommendation to the Board of Supervisors to re-appoint Gary Ward to represent the Livestock Industry on the El Dorado County Agricultural Commission for a four (4) year term beginning January, 2010.

Following the Board's action to re-appoint Gary Ward, his term (January 2010 to January 2014) will begin at the regularly scheduled Agricultural Commission meeting of January 13, 2010.
