



RESOLUTION NO. 129-2014

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

RESOLUTION MAKING A DETERMINATION OF PUBLIC BENEFIT AND APPROVING FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR THE DEDICATION OF ECHO SUMMIT AS A CALIFORNIA HISTORICAL LANDMARK

WHEREAS, County wishes to encourage tourism, agriculture, and economic development in the County by supporting promotional, cultural, and community activities; and

WHEREAS, County has appropriated funding for the purpose of providing assistance to entities to support promotional, cultural, and community activities throughout the County; and

WHEREAS, at its June 10, 2014 meeting, the Board of Supervisors heard Agenda item 14-0785, a presentation from Laurence Crabtree, Forest Supervisor, Eldorado National Forest, on the California Historic Landmark dedication of Echo Summit, which served as the high-altitude training center for the U.S. Olympic Men's Track and Field team and site of the 1968 U.S. Olympic Track and Field Trials; and

WHEREAS, on June 10, 2014, the Board of Supervisors approved Agenda item 14-0785, authorizing the contribution of \$5,000 to support the dedication of Echo Summit as a California Historic Landmark; and

WHEREAS, the funding provided herein will provide a valuable public service that will promote cultural and historical preservation activities which enhance tourism and encourage a sense of community to the people of the County of El Dorado; and


WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has determined that a public benefit is derived from the dedication of Echo Summit as a California Historic Landmark.


