## **RESOLUTION NO. 8939**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE REQUESTING \$20,000 IN FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FROM EL DORADO COUNTY FOR THE 2020/2021 FISCAL YEAR TO HELP OFFSET SOME OF THE OPERATIONAL COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH PROVIDING A COMPREHENSIVE AQUATICS PROGRAM AT THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE AQUATICS CENTER

WHEREAS, the City and El Dorado County continue to work together for the benefit of our community; and

WHEREAS, in the past the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors has been sympathetic to the fact that approximately 75% of the people who utilize the City Aquatics Center reside out-side the City limits; and

**WHEREAS,** the City requests \$20,000 for Fiscal Year 2020/2021 to offset some of the maintenance and operational costs associated with providing a comprehensive aquatics program during the summer months; and

**WHEREAS,** the City has an opportunity to request additional funding from El Dorado County for emergency repairs to the facility:

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Placerville hereby requests \$20,000 in financial assistance from El Dorado County for the 2020/2021 Fiscal Year to help offset some of the operational costs associated with providing a comprehensive aquatics program at the City Aquatics Center.
