STANDARD TERMS AND CONDITIONS

By shipping on this Purchase Order Contract, Vendor warrants that they have read and agree to be bound by these terms and conditions.

1. Taxes: County is exempt from payment of Federal Excise Tax; Federal tax should not be included in any prices contained herein.

 Alterations: No alteration in any of the terms, conditions, delivery, price, quantities, specifications or services of this contract will be effective without prior written consent of the County.

3. Failure to Deliver: Time is of the essence and the contract is subject to cancellation for failure to deliver on time. If Vendor fails to deliver an article or service of the quality or quantity, in the manner or within the time called for by this contract: such article or service may be bought from any source by County. If a greater price than named in this contract is paid for such article or service, the excess cost will be charged to and collected from Vendor or sureties on its bond if bond had been required; or, the County may terminate the contract for default; or, the County may return deliveries already made and receive a refund. For any exception to the delivery date as specified in this contract, the Vendor shall give prior notification and obtain approval thereto from the County. Failure or refusal of Vendor to perform any work or service or do any act required under this contract shall constitute a default.

4. Force Majeure: Vendor shall not be liable for any delay or failure to deliver any or all the goods or services if that delay or failure is caused by labor disputes, strikes, war, riots, insurrection, civil commotion, fire, flood, accident, storm or any act of God. The County shall not be liable for failure to take delivery of the goods attributable to any of the causes specified in this paragraph if they render it commercially impractical for the County to receive the goods. When either Vendor or the County claims an excuse for nonperformance under this paragraph, they must give reasonable notice to the other party.

5. Proposal, Quotation and Attachments: This contract incorporates by reference on the face of this form, the provisions of any related bid request issued by County, any bid submitted by Vendor, or both. This contract incorporates by reference on the face of this form, the provision of any attachments. Vendor agrees that in the event of conflicting language between this contract and Vendor's printed form, the provisions of this contract shall take precedence. This section shall supersede any language in the Vendor's terms and conditions attempting to nullify County terms and conditions.

6. Warranty:

6.1 Warranty For Goods: Vendor warrants that any and all goods covered by this contract will be (i) new and suitable for the use intended, unless otherwise specified; (ii) will conform to the drawings, specifications, samples, description and time provisions furnished by the County; (iii) of the grade and quality specified; (vi) free from defect in design, material and workmanship; and (v) in compliance with all applicable federal, state and local laws and regulations. At County's option, Vendor shall repair or replace the goods without charge within five (5) business days from being notified of the nonconformance with the foregoing warranties. If, after notice, the Vendor cannot promptly replace or repair the goods. Vendor shall refund the full purchase price paid by County for such goods. Defective goods rejected by the County may, without prejudice to any other legal remedy (including, without limitation, incidental and consequential damages) be held at Vendor's risk and returned to Vendor at Vendor's expense. This warranty shall not be deemed to be waived by the County for any reason, including, without limitation, the County's acceptance of the goods or the County's failure to notify Vendor thereof. Further, the failure of the County to reasonably specify any defects in rejected goods shall not prevent the County from relying on the defect to establish a breach, even though the Vendor could have cured the defect on proper notification.

6.2 <u>Warranty for Services</u>: Vendor warrants to County that any and all materials and equipment incidental to services that are furnished under this contract will be new unless otherwise specified and that all services will be of good quality, free from faults and defects and in conformance with the contract. Neither final payment nor inspection of Vendor's services shall constitute an acceptance of services not done in accordance with this contract or relieve Vendor of liability in respect to any express warranties or responsibilities for faulty material or workmanship. Upon request of County, Vendor shall immediately remedy any defects in the services, materials and/or equipment and pay for any damage resulting therefrom. The County shall have the unqualified option to make any needed replacement or repairs itself or to have such replacement or repairs done by the Vendor. In the event the County elects to have said work performed by the Vendor. In the event the County; however, in no event shall such period exceed fifteen (15) calendar days. If the Vendor shall fail or refuse to comply with its obligations under this section, the County shall be entitled to all costs and expenses, including attorney's fees, reasonably incurred by reason of the said failure or refusal.

7. Termination: At any time and without cause, the County shall have the right, at its sole discretion, to terminate this contract by giving seven (7) calendar days written notice to Vendor. 10. Assignment: This contract may not be assigned in whole or in part without the prior written consent of the County.

11. Independent Capacity: In the performance of this contract, agents and employees of the Vendor shall act in an independent capacity and not as officers, employees or agents of the County.

12. Indemnity: The Vendor shall defend, indemnify and hold the County harmless against and from any and all claims, suits, losses, damages and liability for damages of every name, kind and description, including attorneys fees and costs incurred, brought for, or on account of, injuries to or death of any person, including but not limited to workers, County employees and the public, or damages to property or any economic or consequential losses, which are claimed to or in any way arise out of, or connected with the Vendor's services, operations or performance hereunder, regardless of the existence or degree of fault or negligence on the part of the County, the Vendor and employee(s) or any of these, except for the sole or active negligence of the County, its officers and employees, or as expressly proscribed by statute. 13. Nondiscrimination: Vendor shall comply with all applicable federal, state and local laws, rules and regulations in regard to nondiscrimination in employment because of race, color, ancestry, national origin, religion, sex, marital status, age, medical condition, pregnancy, disability or other prohibited basis. All nondiscrimination rules or regulations required by law to be included in this contract are incorporated by this reference.

14. Infringement: The Vendor agrees to defend and hold the County, its officers, agents, employees and volunteers harmless from any and all actions, suits, liabilities, penalties, settlements, losses, damages, costs, charges, attorney's fees, and all other expenses which may arise directly or indirectly from any claim that any of the products or services supplied by Vendor infringes any patent, copyright, trade secret, trademark, or other intellectual property right.

15. Applicable Law and Forum: This contract shall be construed and interpreted according to the substantive law of the State of California excluding the law of conflicts. Any action arising out this contract shall be brought in El Dorado County, California and shall be resolved in accordance with the laws of the state of California.

16. Funding: Funds for this contract are available on a fiscal year basis. Should sufficient funds not be budgeted and appropriated for the payment of goods or services described herein, this contract shall be cancelled in its entirety without penalty or expense to the County of any kind, except for payment for those goods that have been delivered and accepted by the County or services satisfactorily rendered through the date of termination.

17. Business License: It is unlawful for any person to furnish supplies or services or transact any kind of business in the unincorporated territory of El Dorado County without possessing a County business license unless exempt under County Code Section 5.08.070. Health and Human Services Agency recommending the Board:

 Make findings in accordance with Section 3.12.160.B. of the El Dorado County Ordinance Code exempting the competitive bidding process for the purchase of commercial animal kennels and accessories due to the unique nature of this equipment;
 Authorize the sole source acquisition of 19 Shor-Line T-Kennel System commercial animal kennels (fixed assets), inclusive of T-Kennel accessories (bowl kits, feed trays, side transfers, and guillotine enclosures, etc., itemized on the attached quote), through Midmark Corporation dba Shor-Line; and

3) Authorize the Purchasing Agent to issue a purchase order in the net amount of \$114,186.93, including applicable taxes and fees.

FUNDING: 60.6% City of South Lake Tahoe, 28.3% General Fund, 3.6% State Public Health Realignment and 7.5% El Dorado County licenses/permits, fees, and fines. (No Federal Funds)

DISCUSSION / BACKGROUND:

In August of 2006, the County of El Dorado (County) Chief Administrative Office (CAO) Procurement and Contracts Division, on behalf of the Health and Human Services Agency (HHSA), issued an Invitation for Bid (IFB) 07-040-016 to solicit ten commercial grade modular dog kennels and accessories from kennel manufacturers, intended for use at the HHSA Animal Shelter located in South Lake Tahoe (SLT). Only two bids were received, in which Shor-Line T-Kennel Systems, Inc., was selected as the best value bidder, with the resulting bid award and purchase approved by the Board of Supervisors on August 22, 2006 (File ID 06-1289). In 2006, these kennels were purchased and initially placed in temporary modular buildings to house animals at the SLT Shelter while the shelter was undergoing renovation. These Shor-Line T-Kennel Systems have since been reinstalled in the SLT Shelter and are in great working condition.

In December of 2007, the CAO Procurement and Contracts Division, issued IFB 07-040-065 to solicit 37 commercial grade modular dog kennels and accessories from kennel manufacturers, for intended use at the HHSA West Slope Animal Shelter. A single bid was received by Shor-Line T-Kennel Systems, Inc., which was awarded for purchase and approved by the Board on January 23, 2007 (File ID 07-035). These Shor-Line T-Kennel Systems and accessories were purchased for West Slope operations, and since initial installation in 2008, have been transferred and reinstalled twice for shelter use and are presently housing animals securely in the Animal Shelter located in Diamond Springs.

The Shor-Line T-Kennel Systems and accessories purchased by the County in 2006 and

2007 continue to be utilized for HHSA Animal Shelter operations in both Slopes. Being 15 years old with no failures, these Shor-Line T-Kennel Systems and accessories have proven to be a high-quality product and offer a great value to the County.

In contrast, due to a restricted budget during its remodel, the SLT Animal Shelter was also equipped with low-quality particle board kennels, that were purchased for temporary use to house stray and adoptable animals. These kennels have been steadily failing over the years and pose safety hazards and the potential for the animals to escape. To address this issue, HHSA budgeted the purchase of new long-term use animal kennels for the SLT Shelter in HHSA's Fiscal Year 2022-23 Fixed Asset Budget.

In preparation for this SLT Animal Shelter kennel replacement project, HHSA Animal Services staff explored options for kennel purchase and identified Shor-Line T-Kennel Systems and kennel accessories as the desired replacement kennel equipment due to the follow reasons:

- The industry remains very small for commercial kennel production as HHSA Animal Services staff performed market research to identify kennel manufacturers and were unable to identify any other vendors that offered the same quality T-Kennel Systems as Shor-Line.
- Shor-Line T-Kennel Systems are well known in the industry as a quality product for long-term use, adaptability, and durability, as evidenced by the T-Kennel Systems still in use at the County's East and West Slope Animal Shelters since 2006/2007.
- HHSA Animal Services wants to standardize the kennels used at both Slopes, and match existing T-Kennels Systems used in the SLT Shelter. Standardization will allow both shelters to utilize existing County-owned T-Kennel System surplus parts and allow both shelters the advantage of cost-saving benefits by sharing the same kennel systems.
- Animal Services can maximize funding by being able to interchange/transfer T-Kennels Systems between the County's Animal Shelters as needed.
- Uniqueness of Product: Shor-Line T-Kennel Systems provide the following unique benefits:

1) Offer disease control protection as the kennels are equipped with a full T-Cover (unique drain cap system) keeping pets out of the drainage channel.

2) The compartmentalized drain flooring system allows the HHSA Animal Shelters to retrofit T-Kennels above or on the ground and allows the County to transfer kennels and utilize between shelters as needed.

3) Shor-Line T-Kennels have side transfer guillotines to allow dual use of each kennel to house two pets and/or provide more space for housed animals.

In 2021, Shor-Line T-Kennels Systems Inc., was acquired by Midmark Corporation, now operating under the name of Midmark Corporation dba Shor-Line, as the direct manufacturer and seller of Shor-Line T-Kennel Systems and kennel accessories. Shor-Line T-Kennels Systems are the industry standard and are also used by Stanislaus County, Sacramento SPCA, City of Los Angeles, Los Angeles County, and the City of Elk Grove, in addition to multiple other counties and agencies throughout California.

Due to the above justification, HHSA Animal Services recommends and El Dorado County Procurement agrees with approval of a sole source purchase of the Shor-Line T-Kennel System kennels and accessories from Midmark Corporation dba Shor-Line for the amount of \$114,186.93, including applicable taxes and fees.

ALTERNATIVES:

Should the Board decline to approve this recommendation, HHSA will be not able to ensure standardization of kennel system equipment is used within both Animal Shelters in El Dorado County, which may lead to the purchase of lower quality kennels, future replacement purchases, and will not allow standardization of parts or equipment or the transfer of kennels in between shelter locations.

A. The good/service requested is restricted to one supplier for the reason stated below:

1. Why is the acquisition restricted to this goods/services supplier? (Explain why the acquisition cannot be competitively bid. Explain if this is an emergency purchase or how the supplier is the only source for the acquisition.)

Shor-Line manufactures/sells a stainless steel kennel system called "T-Kennel" for commercial animal shelter application. T-Kennels are the industry standard for long-term use, adaptability, and durability, as evidenced by the T-Kennels currently used at the Diamond Springs Shelter. Animal Services purchased T-Kennels in 2007 for the Diamond Springs Shelter and wants to standardize the kennels used at both Slopes by purchasing the same T-Kennels for the South Lake Tahoe Shelter. Standardization will allow both shelters to utilize existing County-owned T-Kennel surplus parts, and allow both slopes to benefit by utilizing the same kennel systems. T-Kennels, unlike other commercial kennels provide the following unique benefits:1) Offers disease control protection of a full T-Cover (drain cap system) keeping pets out of the drainage channel. 2) The compartmentalized drain flooring system allows the Shelter to retrofit T-Kennels above or on ground and allows the County to transfer kennels and utilize between shelters if/as needed; and 3) T-Kennels have side transfer guillotines to allow dual use of each kennel to house dual pets (when needed) and/or provide more space.

2. Provide the background of events leading to this acquisition.

The kennels currently installed at the South Lake Tahoe (SLT) Shelter were intended for temporary use and are no longer meeting the needs of the shelter, as they are failing and need replacement. There is the potential for safety hazards to the dogs housed or the potential for escape. The SLT kennels failed around 3 years ago and would have been 11 years old at the point of failure, whereas the ShorLine T-Kennels (purchased in 2007 by the County) that are installed in the Diamond Springs Shelter are currently 15 years old with no failures, and have been transferred and reinstalled twice since the original purchase. The SLT shelter project was initially done economically with a very limited budget so the kennels purchased were budget-based and were not a quality product. Funding had been included in Animal Shelter's FY 22/23 Budget to remove/dispose of the old kennels and to purchase and install new long-term use dog kennels. Animal Shelter is working with County Purchasing to follow the equipment surplus process and it has been determined that the existing kennels need to be removed and disposed of.

3. Describe the uniqueness of the acquisition. (Why was the goods/services supplier chosen?)

With over 35 years in animal shelter management, Henry has tested other kennel types in the past that have failed, were not durable, and/or were nontransferable between shelter locations. Other kennel systems do not offer the drain system sanitation capabilities that Shor-Line provides. Shor-Line's drain cover has been patented and allows solid waste to flow underneath without removing the cover or forcing the waste through a small hole or opening. Due to Henry's experience and knowledge gained through his experience with several dog kennel systems, Henry has witnessed first-hand the durability and customization that Shor-Line T-Kennels provide. T-Kennels are the most customizable kennel options in the industry and are also used by Stanislaus County, Sacramento SPCA, San Francisco SPCA, City of Los Angeles, Los Angeles County, Riverside County, San Diego County, San Diego Humane, City of El Cajon, Orange County and East Bay SPCA, City of Bakersfield, Fresno County, and recently the City of Elk Grove.

4. What are the consequences of not purchasing the goods/services or contracting with the proposed supplier?

Having the same kennels at both shelter locations will allow standardization of parts, equipment, repairs, replacements and allow the County to maximize funding by being able to interchange T-Kennels systems when needed, and to utilize existing surplus parts. Not purchasing through Shor-Line may lead to the purchase of lower quality kennels, future replacement purchases and will not allow standardization of parts or equipment and will not allow the transfer of kennels in between shelter locations.

5. What market research was conducted to substantiate no competition, including evaluation of other items consider? (Provide a narrative of your efforts to identify other similar or appropriate goods/services, including a summary of how the department concluded that such alternatives are either inappropriate or unavailable. The name and addresses of suppliers contacted and the reasons for not considering them must be included OR an explanation of why the survey or effort to identify other goods/services was not performed.)

In 2007, the County issued 2 Request for Bids (RFB) (07-040-016 and 07-040-065) to solicit modular kennels and accessory manufacturers. The first RFB received 2 bids (LGL Animal Care Products, Inc. based out of TX and T-Kennel Systems based out of KS, now owned by Shor-Line). The T-Kennel quote was \$2,000 less in difference for the same specification and awarded due to best value. The second bid was issued in 2007, and T-Kennel Systems was the only bid received/awarded. Currently, the industry remains very small for commercial kennel production as County Animal Services staff performed market research to identify kennel manufacturers and were unable to identify other vendors that offered the same quality stainless steel kennels as Shor-Line. Given that the kennels currently used by Animal Services in Diamond Springs are the Shor-Line T-Kennels, the department wants to ensure standardization for equipment used in both shelters, to ensure interchangeable parts and transferral kennel usage, and trusts the long term durability that has been witnessed first hand by the longevity of the T-Kennels currently owned by the County. These findings substantiates no competition.

B. Price Analysis:

1. How was the price offered determined to be fair and reasonable? (Explain what basis was used for comparison and include cost analysis as applicable.)

see response to question 5 above. T-Kennel Systems was initially selected as the best value in response to Request for Bids issued in 2007 in the first bid issued and was the only bid received from the second bid. There is no industry comparable standard that Animal Services has identified. As identified in Question 3, multiple CA municipality shelters contract with Shor-Line due to the value and product quality of the T-Kennels.

2. Describe any cost savings or avoidance realized (1 time or on-going) by acquiring the goods/services from this supplier.

Having the same kennels at both shelter locations will allow for standardization of parts, equipment, repairs, replacements and allow the County to maximize funding by being able to interchange T-Kennels systems when needed, and to utilize existing surplus parts for kennel modifications and/or repairs. Not purchasing through Shor-Line may lead to the purchase of lower quality kennels, future replacement purchases and will not allow for the standardization of parts or equipment and will not allow the transfer of kennels in between shelter locations. Shor-Line offers a lifetime limited warranty against any defects in material or manufacturing. Items that wear-out, like cables and pulleys have a 1 year warranty.


