OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO Resolution to Name an Unnamed Natural Peak in the Tahoe Basin

"GOLD STAR" PEAK

in Honor of Lake Tahoe's Fallen Soldiers

Whereas, the United States of America has been involved in military combat in Afghanistan since 2001, and Iraq since 2003; and,

Whereas, the following are servicemen killed in action from the Tahoe Basin:

PFC Phillip Brandon Williams, USMC, 21, was killed in Iraq, October 9, 2006 and,

Sergeant Timothy M. Smith, USA, 25, died April 7, 2008 in Baghdad; and,

Specialist Garrett Fant, USA, 21, died September 26, 2011 in Afghanistan; and,

Whereas, it is right and just to honor those who honorably serve in defense of liberty and to provide special honor to those who have paid the ultimate sacrifice; and,

Whereas, there stands an unnamed natural peak in the Lake Tahoe Basin which serves well as such a purpose.

Now, Therefore, be it Resolved, that the Board of Supervisors, of the County of El Dorado, does herewith:

- (1) recognizes and remembers the valiant sacrifice of Brandon Williams, Timothy Smith, and Garret Fant;
- (2) encourages community efforts to properly memorialize those sacrifices; and,
- (3) supports the naming of the natural peak located in the Lake Tahoe Basin at Latitude 39 degrees 15 minutes 23.2 seconds West (39.25644 N) and Longitude 120 degrees 5 minutes 18.5 seconds North (120.08847 W) to be called "Gold Star Peak" in remembrance; and
- (4) requests the Board on Geographical Names to approve the naming of this natural feature and include it on all future federal publications.
