

The County of El Dorado Zoning Administrator will hold a special meeting and public hearing in the Building C Hearing Room, 2850 Fairlane Court, Placerville, CA 95667 on June 24, 2026, at 3:00 p.m., to consider the following: Tentative Parcel Map P23-0005/ Native Lane submitted by DEUBEL ENTERPRISES, LP request to subdivide an undeveloped 39.99-acre parcel into four (4) parcels ranging in size from 5.25 acres to 15.55 acres. The property, identified by Assessor's Parcel Number 109-010-003, consisting of 39.99 acres, is located on the south side of Native Lane, approximately 1,500 feet south of the intersection with Flying C Court, west of the Shingle Springs Rural Region, and south of the unincorporated community of Cameron Park area, Supervisorial District 2.
