Dear Mr. Stanton:

The construction of the OU-1 landfill cap at the Meyers Landfill in El Dorado County, California, occurred during the periods of 6 July 2010 through 22 August 2013. Geosyntec provided qualified CQA personnel on site to monitor the construction activities as required by the CQA Manual. All significant construction of the OU-1 cap was completed by the Sukut Construction, with the exception of vegetation establishment, prior to 11 October 2012

During the 2013 construction season, Sukut completed repairs to the OU-1 cap from the previous winter and continued onsite re-vegetation efforts. As listed in Section 32 92 00 of the specifications, a satisfactory stand of vegetation is defined as having a minimum of 10 plants/ft². Section 32 92 00 also requires 35% coverage at the end of the Establishment Period. The results of Geosyntec's 7 October 2013 vegetation survey measured 18 plants/ft² and 35% coverage on the on-landfill portion of the site.

This letter shall serve as Geosyntec's Final Certification for Payment. In accordance with the Contract Documents, based on on-site monitoring and surveys, I certify to the County that to the best of my knowledge, the construction of the OU-1 cap and appurtenances, as well as the on-landfill re-vegetation efforts have been completed in accordance with the Contract Documents, as revised and documented in the CQA report. Final amount due to the contractor, Sukut Construction, shall be determined by the County of El Dorado.
