Dear Board Members:

Recommendation:

The Development Services Department – Building Services recommends that the Board of Supervisors take the following action:

- 1. Make findings that it is more economical and feasible to obtain an outside contractor for the provision of commercial grading plan review services in accordance with Government Code 31000 and pursuant to County Charter section 210(b)(6); and
- 2. Approve Agreement 154-S0711 with R.E.Y. Engineers, Agreement 155-S0711 with Interwest Consulting Group and Agreement 156-S0711 Dokken Engineering for plan review services on an "as needed" basis, for a term of one year in an amount not to exceed \$30,000 each with an aggregate total of \$90,000; and
- 3. Authorize the Chairman to execute the Agreement.

Reason for Recommendation:

On July 1, 2006 the Development Services Department assumed the commercial grading permitting responsibilities from the Department of Transportation. We have been unsuccessful in recruiting for qualified engineers to perform the plan reviews necessary for permit issuance so we must contract for these services until such time as we are successful in hiring staff. We are proposing to contract with three consultants to allow greater flexibility in the distribution of the projects with the goal in mind of streamlining the review process as much as possible.

The Development Services Department will administer these agreements.

Fiscal Impact:

There is no increase in net County cost. The funds expended will be reimbursed by the applicants for the projects through an Agreement For Payment of Processing Fees executed by the property owner at the time the permit application is submitted. This agreement provides for time and materials billings of County staff time at the current rate of \$100 per hour and the direct pass-through of costs from the Consultant. Funds for these contracts are included in the 0607 budget.

Action to be Taken Following Approval:

- 1. The Board Clerk's Office will forward the executed agreements to the Development Services Department for distribution.
- 2. The Chief Administrator's Office, Procurement and Purchasing Division, will encumber the funds.
- 3. The Development Services Department will administer the agreement consistent with generally accepted contract administration practices and government accepted accounting principles/practices.
