



RESOLUTION NO. 074-2021

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado conducted a hearing on the appropriations limit for El Dorado County on June 29, 2021;

WHEREAS, the hearing was advertised and noticed as required by law: and,

WHEREAS, the Board received testimony and other evidence regarding the appropriation limitation to be established for El Dorado County; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado that the El Dorado County appropriations limit for the 2021-2022 fiscal year, as described in Article XIII B of the State Constitution and implemented by Chapter 1205, Statutes of 1980 is the sum of \$252,653,563 computed as follows:

2021-2022 Increase in the California per capita personal income is 5.73% or the factor of 1.0573;
2021-2022 Increase in Population is 0.96% or the factor of 1.0096;
1.0573 (X) 1.0096 = 1.0675 is the combined factor for increasing the 2020-2021 appropriation limitation.

Growth Factor FY 2021-2022:	<u>1.0675</u>
Limit for FY 2021-2022:	\$252,653,563
