



Project Landscaping Plan






Proposed Project – Building Elevation






Proposed Project Monument Sign

Mitigated Negative Declaration

Technical Studies

- Air Quality and Greenhouse Gas Emissions Study
- Biological Resources and Wetland Delineation
- Oak Tree Report
- Cultural Resources
- Geotechnical Report
- Phase I Environmental Site Assessment
- Traffic Report

Note – the Initial Study for the project considered all CEQA topics



Transportation

- Level of Service (LOS) Study Prepared
 - No longer used for CEQA
 - No impacts to study intersections
- Vehicle Miles Travelled (VMT)
 - New metric for evaluating transportation impacts
 - Required July 1, 2020
 - OPR Guidance: Retail stores below 50,000 SF generally do not require a quantitative study
 - A qualitative VMT memorandum and economic analysis support classifying the proposed project as local retail



Potentially Significant Impacts and Mitigation Measures

Impacts

- Nesting birds
- Tribal Cultural Resources

Mitigation

- Pre-construction bird survey; establish exclusion zones if nests are present.
- Procedures for discovery of previously unidentified artifacts during construction
