I have recently come across news articles that have given me cause for concern. I believe in light of these issues it is fully apparent that our county can no longer justify any further shelter in place orders. Not now, and not come fall. Please let me explain why.

It appears that we have reached a level of hypocrisy within the science community. I say this respectfully and with no malice to anyone. The reason I say like this though is because, when the health experts can gather over 1,000 signatures on a letter stating that it is perfectly reasonable to assume protestors are responsible enough to conduct protests without the risk of being shut down and our businesses are not. That becomes a problem. How does the science account for that? When the health experts, state the subject of racism and police injustice is set above the peoples ability to provide for their families and support their livelihoods, this is a problem. The statement made was that racism is worst than the disease caused by Covid19. I would like to point out two simple facts.
