



RESOLUTION NO. 059-2013

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado conducted a hearing on the appropriations limit for El Dorado County on June 11, 2013; and,

WHEREAS, the hearing was advertised and noticed as required by law; and,

WHEREAS, the Board received testimony and other evidence regarding the appropriation limitation to be established for El Dorado County; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado that the El Dorado County appropriations limit for the 2013-2014 fiscal year, as described in Article XIII B of the State Constitution and implemented by Chapter 1205, Statutes of 1980 is the sum of \$176,261,521 computed as follows:

2013-2014 Increase in the California per capita personal income is 5.12% or the factor of 1.0512;

2013-2014 Increase in Population is 0.0032% or the factor of 1.0032;

$1.0512 (X) 1.0032 = 1.0546$ is the combined factor for increasing the 2012-2013 appropriation limitation.


