SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 5025,  
AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A COMPREHENSIVE  
UPDATE TO CHAPTER 130.16 (SIGNS) OF  
TITLE 130 (ZONING ORDINANCE)  
THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY  
OF EL DORADO DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:  
The proposed Ordinance is a comprehensive update  
to the County's existing Sign Ordinance (Chapter  
130.16 of Title 130 of the El Dorado County Code of  
Ordinances, and other sections of Title 130 address-  
ing sign regulations and standards) as well as  
amendments to General Plan Land Use Element Ob-  
jective 2.7.1 and Policy 2.7.1.2 (pertaining to off-site  
signs) consistent with the goals of the project. The  
proposed ordinance shall replace the existing Chap-  
ter 130.16 pertaining to the regulation of signs in the  
unincorporated area of the County and shall be treat-  
ed and considered as a new and comprehensive or-  
dinance which shall supersede all previously adopted  
standards and ordinances regarding signs. The pro-  
posed ordinance applies to general sign require-  
ments, permanent signs, temporary signs, commu-  
nity sign programs, sign development and design  
standards, permit requirements, and review proce-  
dures for signs, including prohibited, illegal, abandon-  
ed and nonconforming signs, and signs on County
