

## **PROCLAMATION**

## Of the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado In Recognition of Pat Dwyer

WHEREAS, the mission of the El Dorado County Fire Safe Council is to protect the people of El Dorado County and their property from the effects of catastrophic wildfire through education, cooperation, innovation, and action, with this mission guiding the Council's goals to coordinate a county-wide Fire Plan, to educate the public about fire threat and fire prevention measures, and to promote "Firewise" communities; and,

WHEREAS, guided by the leadership and tireless efforts of Pat Dwyer, the El Dorado County Fire Safe Council has developed a strong network of partnerships with community based Associate Fire Safe Councils as well as local, regional, state and federal organizations that serves to coordinate the resources, knowledge and mutual objectives of each of these organizations in order to protect the citizens, homes, communities and natural resources throughout the County of El Dorado from catastrophic wildfire; and,
