To El Dorado County Board of Supervisors:

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on Consent Agenda Item 26-0284 on the February 10, 2026 Board of Supervisors Agenda. As noted in the staff report for this agenda item, your timely approval supports the process to extend the South Lake Tahoe Recreation Facilities JPA special taxes that provide funding for County-owned bicycle trails in the South Lake Tahoe area. Since your staff report was prepared, the JPA adopted a resolution Calling An Election on January 22, 2026, and the County Registrar of Voters has placed Measure G on the ballot for the June 2, 2026 Primary Election. Both of the Third Amendments, once adopted by your Board, the City of South Lake Tahoe, and the Tahoe Paradise Recreation and Park District, are only effective if the voters approve Measure G by the required 2/3rds majority. I urge you to keep this item on the Consent Agenda and approve as proposed.
