**Resolution for Road Closure for the 2014  
“Parade of Lights”**

**WHEREAS**, The Georgetown Divide Rotary (sponsor) desires to hold the “Parade of Lights” in Georgetown on Saturday, December 6, 2014; and

**WHEREAS**, said sponsors have applied for a Road Closure Permit pursuant to Vehicle Code 21101(e), Ordinance Code §12.37.010 et seq., and County Resolution 110-79 in order to promote the “Parade of Lights” on Saturday, December 6, 2014; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that a road closure will be in effect for Main Street from Harkness Street to Hwy 193 in Georgetown from 3:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Saturday, December 6, 2014, subject to the conditions set forth in Resolution No. 110-79 dated May 1, 1979.


This Resolution and the Application with conditions shall together constitute the Road Closure Permit.
