



**RESOLUTION NO. 051-2022**

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

**11th Annual Independence Day Firework Display  
El Dorado Hills Town Center  
Saturday, July 2, 2022**

**WHEREAS**, Pyro Spectaculars, Inc. desires to conduct a fireworks display at the Eleventh Annual Independence Day Firework display at the El Dorado Hills Town Center in El Dorado Hills on Saturday July 2, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 8.08.050 of the County Ordinance Code restricts the use, possession, or discharge of fireworks to persons authorized by written order of the Board of Supervisors in full compliance with any conditions or restrictions contained in such order; and

**WHEREAS**, The El Dorado Hills Fire Protection District, the El Dorado County Sheriff's Department, shall have the right to revoke the permission to hold the display at any time due to extreme fire or other specific danger, up to and including when the display is to begin; and

**WHEREAS**, approval is contingent upon the obtainment of all permission, insurance and/or paid permits that may be needed from the County of El Dorado and/or other agencies.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors hereby grants Pyro Spectaculars, Inc. permission to conduct the requested display on Saturday July 2, 2022, only, and provided that they comply fully with the aforementioned and any other additional requirements deemed necessary by fire control authorities.
