SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE

ORDINANCE NO. _____

Pursuant to California Government Code section 25124(b)(1), the County of El Dorado Board of Supervisors will hold a public meeting in the Board of Supervisors Meeting Room, 330 Fair Lane, Placerville, CA 95667 on August 22, 2023 to consider the second reading and final passage of Ordinance ___ that would delegate to the Director of Transportation (Director) the authority to perform any or all acts necessary to acquire any interest in or easement upon real property for the purposes of a public structure, road, trail, or improvement as previously approved by the Board of Supervisors or as part of the approved Capital Improvement Program, with the delegated authority limited to real property acquisitions of \$25,000 or less in value. The proposed Ordinance would replace similar authority granted by Ordinance 5094, which is set to expire on November 9, 2023. The proposed Ordinance would also delegate to the Director the authority to commence a project's Right-of-Way (ROW) phase, as defined; authorize the Director to perform any and all acts necessary to approve and accept any minor Addendums to Acquisitions or Easements upon real property, subject to approval by County Counsel as to form; and delegate to the Deputy Director of Engineering the signature authority to approve and accept all escrow and title company transactions related to acquisitions for ROW purpose. The proposed Ordinance would be effective 30 days after final adoption by the County Board of Supervisors.

The Board would also consider and vote on whether the adoption of the Ordinance would not be a project within the meaning of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), or even if it were a project whether it would be exempt under CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3).

All persons interested are invited to write their comments to the Board of Supervisors in advance of the Second Reading, to take place on August 22, 2023 via the Consent Calendar. If you challenge the proposed Ordinance in court, you may be limited to raising only those items you or someone else raised at the public meeting described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Board of Supervisors at, or before, the public meeting.
