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SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE

ORDINANCE NO. 5194

Pursuant to California Government Code section 25124(b)(1), the County of El Dorado Board of Supervisors will hold a public meeting in the Board of Supervisors Meeting Room, 330 Fair Lane, Placerville, CA 95667 on March 5, 2024, to consider the second reading and final passage of Ordinance 5194 that would increase the threshold at which a Road Improvement Agreement (RIA) is required for improvements that are located within any portion of the right-of-way of any County highway from \$100,000 to \$250,000, as well as clarify the amount and type of security (bonds) required under all RIAs with the County. Additionally, the proposed Ordinance would delegate signature authority for RIAs with a total cost estimate of up to \$1,000,000 to the Director of Transportation, subject to approval by County Counsel as to form, along with the authority to sign amendments and to accept the project as complete to initiate the warranty period for such projects. The proposed Ordinance would be effective 30 days after final adoption by the County Board of Supervisors.

The Board would also consider and vote on whether the adoption of the Ordinance would not be a project within the meaning of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), or even if it were a project whether it would be exempt under CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3).

All persons interested are invited to write their comments to the Board of Supervisors in advance of the Second Reading, to take place on March 5, 2024, via the Consent Calendar. If you challenge the proposed Ordinance in court, you may be limited to raising only those items you or someone else raised at the public meeting described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Board of Supervisors at, or before, the public meeting.
