We deeply appreciate your support for the concerns of the citizens of our community.

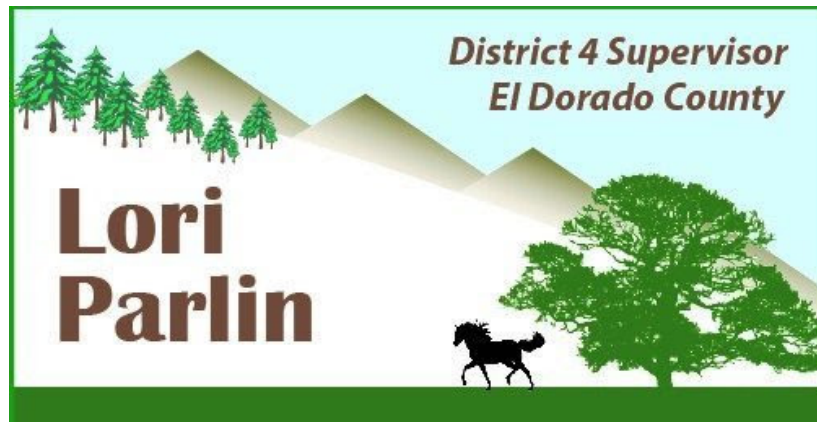

**Board to discuss letter**  
**addressing the Auburn State Recreation Area Plan**



**The El Dorado County Board of Supervisors will be discussing approval of a letter to the Bureau of Reclamation on the future plans of Auburn State Recreation Area (ASRA) and its potential impacts to El Dorado County residents.**

The ASRA Plan does not have a defined proposal or funding mechanism for infrastructure improvements, vegetation management, fire breaks, or additional staffing to accommodate and manage the increased number of visitors that will be attracted to the area. Several years of drought and increased water rates have caused much of this area to be dry and prone to fire. At the August 15th ASRA open house in Cool, 150-200 residents showed up to express concerns about traffic and fire safety resulting from this project. As such, residents have asked the Board of Supervisors for support to require that public safety be a priority of any proposed plan. Additionally, Planning staff is preparing technical CEQA responses to the Draft Environmental Impact Report (DEIR).
