Resolution of Road Closure for the  
Second Annual / 2011  
Cameron Park "Run with Santa"

**WHEREAS**, The Cameron Park Community Services District (CSD) and Scenario Communications (co-sponsors) desire to hold the Second Annual Cameron Park "Run with Santa" event on Saturday, December 3, 2011; and

**WHEREAS**, said sponsors have applied for a Road Closure Permit pursuant to Vehicle Code 21102(e), Ordinance Code §12.37.010 et seq., and County Resolution 110-79 in order to promote the Second Annual "Run with Santa" event on Saturday, December 3, 2011; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that a road closure will be in effect for Country Club Drive between Bass Lake Road and Knollwood Drive; Merrychase Drive between Greenwood Lane and Country Club Drive; Knollwood Drive between Country Club Drive and Greenwood Lane; and Greenwood Lane between Knollwood Drive and Merrychase Drive in Cameron Park, on Saturday, December 3, 2011, between 6:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m, subject to the conditions set forth in Resolution No. 110-79 dated May 1, 1979, and subject to the conditions set forth in the "Application for Road Closure" submitted for this event.

This Resolution and the Application with conditions shall together constitute the Road Closure Permit.
